SBA Low Interest Disaster Loans Available for Business Owners, Homeowners & Renters in Florida

If you are a business, homeowner, renter, or nonprofit who suffered damages as a result of Hurricane Ian, the U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA) may be able to assist you with a low interest disaster loan to help repair or replace property not covered by insurance or other sources:

To be considered for all forms of disaster assistance, begin by registering with FEMA online at DisasterAssistance.gov, download the FEMA mobile app, visit a recovery center ([DRC Locator \(fema.gov\)](https://DRCLocator(fema.gov))), or call 800-621-3362.

There are three options to apply for SBA: (1) online at <https://disasterloanassistance.sba.gov/ela/s/>, (2) visit a recovery center or (3) request a paper application by calling Customer Service at 800-659-2955.
